



Easy Way to Remove Protective Film From Mirrors

Your GhostBlind comes with a protective film on the front of the mirrors that must be removed.

Hint: Do not leave the blind in the direct sunlight or in excessive heat before removing the protective film. Heat may cause the adhesive to stick to the mirror surface.

It is best to lay the blind flat on the floor with the mirror side up. If the blind is room temperature, the protective film can be removed more easily. **Start to remove film from the bottom of the blind, not the top. Do NOT kneel on the blind**

The easiest way to start to remove the protective film is to use scotch tape, masking tape, duct tape or any aggressive tape.

Start at the **bottom corners**, rather than at the top.

1. Wipe off any dust if needed.
2. Apply tape as shown. Press down firmly.
3. Pull the tape **straight back NOT UP**, slowly as shown.
